Each of these sessions incorporates the best of a blended or online teaching strategy, with asynchronous and synchronous components.

Session 1: Lesson Planning for Blended Learning

This session will help you conceptualize how to plan asynchronous and synchronous instruction that allows you to meet the needs of a variety of learners. Participants will work to identify the building blocks of their instruction and identify ways for students to learn both on tech and off tech.

Session 2: Flipped Classroom

This session will do two things for participants. The first is to experience a flipped lesson as the learner and the second is to learn about the flipped classroom methodology as well as simple and complex applications.

Session 3: Hyperdocs

HyperDocs are self-paced, student navigated lessons. They are able to be highly differentiated. Prior to coming to the session, participants will complete, explore and explain a hyperdoc you'll receive. Our synchronous session will focus on debriefing and thinking about where and how hyperdocs could be best leveraged within our own practices.
