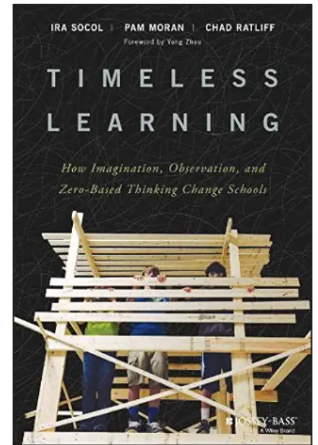
Merging Equity and Innovation into Our Schools
