Day 2: Unmistakable Impact: Participants will learn how to dramatically improve instruction

- Achieving improvement through precise explanations of practices
- seeking out and implementing high-leverage teaching practices and high leverage professional learning practices
- achieving results by focusing principals, coaches, workshops, and teams on achieving the Instructional Improvement Target
- putting humanity at the center by recognizing and celebrating the professionalism of teachers
