Literacy as Life Disciplinary Literacy & Performance Assessment Design Instructor: Alysia Backman, M.Ed.


Target Audience: Middle & High School Content Teachers

This 3 credit graduate course will build knowledge of creating curriculumembedded performance assessments based on proficiency-based graduation requirements (PBGRS) and standards such as Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics, Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) and other disciplinary standards, such as those related to the arts, world language, health and physical education, and technology.



- Deepen understanding of how disciplinary literacy practices including *transferable skills*, connect to the development of performance assessments for the purpose of assessing both proficiencies and literacy.
- Explore different disciplinary literacy instruction and strategies to be used in the classroom
- Discuss the research of performance assessment systems and disciplinary literacy
- Understand design elements of performance assessment systems
- Create a performance assessment based on proficiencies and standards
- Implement a curriculum-embedded performance assessment within a disciplinary unit
- Analyze data from the performance assessment to inform next steps in instruction and design of performance assessment systems
