





## **Personalized Learning Using Technology**

Target Audience: Classroom teachers and Principals K-12

This 3-credit course will look at a process to implement *personalized learning* into your classroom or school district and the role technology can play for both showcasing work and supporting student learning. Using the resources established by the VT AOE, we will look at the components of a Personal Learning Plan (PLP) and how to take that back and use it with students. We will be focusing both on the PLPs and student portfolio creation for younger students.

## Participants will:

- Examine the theory and design of PLPs
- Explore technology tools, recognizing and evaluating apps and Web 2.0 tools that support developing PLPs
- Design a prototype of a student PLP, explaining how technology would support the plan, and create a portfolio template for showcasing work
- Explore the use of UDL (Universal Design for learning) principles to help create PLPs designed for all students no matter what their level of learning
- Will receive a Chromebook that will be used throughout the course in the development of personalized learning skill sets.
