Writing Workshop: Beyond the Units of Study

Target Audience: Grades K-6 Literacy Teachers

Course Methods: Two-day Institute with Leah Mermelstein and Beth Moore going beyond the Writing Units of Study- emphasizing informational text and essay writing. The workshop will include breakout sessions at grade spans.

The full course will share methods of teaching writing, including writing workshop, mini-lessons, conferring, small group work, shared writing, and interactive writing. You will experience workshop simulation, video-clips, role-play, analyzing samples of student work, and hands-on unit planning.

Learning Goals: You will learn how to design a unit of study for writing workshop, from launch to publishing. Alongside planning whole class instruction, participants will plan for differentiation – this will include building a conferring toolkit and demonstration notebook, as well as creating examples of writing to share with students. The course will also include hands-on practice with assessment tools for monitoring student progress, planning for individualized instructions, and goal-setting. Participants will design a complete unit of study for writing workshop.

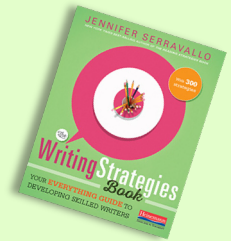
